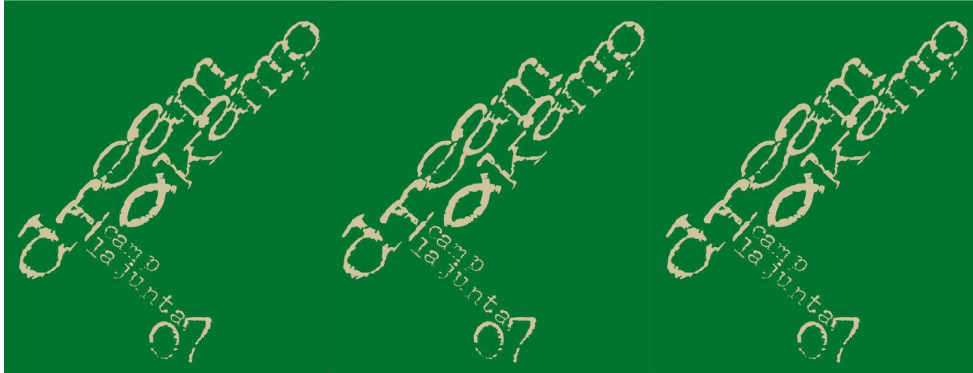

What is DreamKamp?

DreamKamp was created in the fall of 1997 with the goal of developing a dynamic camping experience for Kerr County kids at one of the hill country's fine, traditional camps. Camp La Junta agreed to host the camp the first year and after seeing the affect it had on the kids, they volunteered to host it indefinitely with the help of community support. Teachers and student counselors nominate students who will be entering the sixth and seventh grades. The process for selection is not based on grades or extracurricular performance, but reaches out to students who have that special spark which sometimes can go unrecognized. These students demonstrate a positive attitude and leadership potential giving them the chance to do out-of-the-ordinary activities during their summer. Letters received from the campers after their week of camp testify "this is truly a great experience" and many say "it was one of the best weeks of my life".

The week of camp activities includes horseback, canoeing, riflery, swimming, SCUBA, kayaking, high ropes, archery, sports, water games, and sailing. A strong counselor staff representing some of La Junta's finest activity instructors, and young adults from area schools and universities, serve to instruct and lead campers in these activities as well as daily spiritual lessons and evening programs. Nightly, there are community leaders, such as coaches, business people and government officials who speak to the DreamKampers about the role which their faith has played in their success. The goals of the program are entertainment, adventure, excitement, spiritual growth and leadership development.

The Kerrville Board of REALTORS® has been supporting DreamKamp as one of their main community projects since 2006. Through the funds raised, in great part from the annual DreamKamp Golf Tournament, we have been able to sponsor between 50 and 75 campers each summer.
